

# 2026-2027 SCHOOL DRESS CODE KINDERGARTEN

Consistent with the principle that God does set standards for Christian modesty and appearance, our school expects its students to avoid extremes in clothing and to dress in good taste with the emphasis being upon cleanliness and neatness.

Clothing that has been outgrown, dirty, torn or represents a sloppy appearance is not permitted.

## **Uniforms**

---

The school board has approved the purchase of school uniforms from **Reds Team Sports** uniform store. The link to Reds can be found on our website at [www.htcsfl.com](http://www.htcsfl.com) or by calling them directly at 813-612-5999.

**Orders must be placed by the designated deadlines from the provided suppliers prior to school starting to guarantee delivery by the first day of school.**

## **Hair**

---

Hair must be neatly trimmed and groomed. Unnatural hair colors are not permitted. Boys' hair length must not touch the collar or ears, and eyes must be clearly visible. Braids are not permitted for boys if they do not meet the required hair length as stated above. The administration reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of hairstyles.

## **Tops**

---

School shirts are sold with the HTCS logo imprinted on the upper left side. School Logo must be worn on ALL shirts to keep with uniformity. **All shirts should fit according to body size, not too small or too large.**

## **Bottoms**

---

Bottoms are black, navy blue or khaki color.

### **For girls, this consists of:**

- Knee length skorts
- Skirts
- Jumpers
- Walking shorts
- Long pants

### **For boys, this consists of:**

- Knee length walking shorts
- Long pants

Shorts should be longer in style. Bottoms must be proper fitting, not too baggy or not too tight. Parents are asked to use good judgment in determining when a child has outgrown his/her uniform. As children grow, uniforms will need replacing. Uniforms should not be worn to school dirty, ripped or torn.

## **Accessories**

---

- Make up is not permitted
- Hats are not acceptable for indoors
- Hoodies, scarves and bandanas are not to be worn with uniform
- Tattoos are not permitted
- Big jewelry is not permitted

## Shoes and Socks

---

Shoes should be a **solid black** for both girls and boys. Shoes may be casual or tennis shoes. Sandals or boots are not permitted at any time during the year. Sock colors for girls and boys should be coordinated with our uniform colors, such as:

- White
- Red
- Navy
- Black

Fad or character socks are not permitted with uniforms. Socks must be seen and not hidden inside the shoe. **If a student is suspected of not wearing socks, they will be written up.**

## Cold Weather Clothing

---

With the onset of cooler weather and/or cool classroom temperatures, the following may be worn *with the uniform shirt*:

- Properly fitting white turtleneck under uniform shirt or one in the same color as the uniform shirt.
- Properly fitting approved jacket from the uniform store.

All jackets permitted for school must be purchased from the uniform store with a logo.

NO OTHER JACKETS will be permitted to be worn at school – inside the building or outside for activities.

If proper outerwear is not in keeping with the uniform dress code colors, students will be asked to remove jackets and sweaters while on the school campus.

## P.E. Clothing

---

An approved uniform is available for P.E. class at the uniform store and **should be worn on P.E. days**. In colder weather sweat pants can be worn with the Harvest Time P.E. shirt. **Students will be graded on dressing out for P.E. class.** An appropriate tennis shoe is also required to participate in P.E. activities. No color restrictions during P.E. on tennis shoes. **Older PE shirt styles will no longer be permitted.** A student's grade will be impacted if they are not in proper uniform during P.E. class.

## Spirit Shirts

---

A spirit shirt is **required** on Fridays with jeans. Spirit shirts **must be ordered** through the uniform store. **Older Spirit shirt styles will no longer be permitted.** **Spirit Wear will also be required on all field trips.** Jeans are permitted on Fridays. Ripped jeans with holes are not permitted. Shorts of any kind are not permitted on Fridays.

## Non-Uniform Day Policy

---

On occasion, certain days may be designated as a "non-uniform day" throughout the school year. The following clothes would be inappropriate on such days:

- Sleeveless shirts or dresses
- Tank-top style shirts
- Short dresses
- Exposed mid-riff shirts
- Clothing with inappropriate pictures or sayings
- Short shorts (shorts must be walking shorts)
- Short skirts/dresses
- Ripped or torn jeans
- Flip flops

**Repeated dress code violations could result in detention, suspension and/or a student being expelled.**
